Temporal Changes to Fire Risk in Dissimilar WUI Communities

Introduction

During the past two decades, governments have begun to pay attention to the safety of communities in the wildland-urban interface (WUI) areas. In 2002, the United States, Canada, Mexico, and Texas have occurred in such of increased fire agency staffing, equipment, and training (National Fire Agency Fire Action 2013). To aid public development and reduce fire risk, we propose to evaluate how risk changes through time in communities expanding into fire-prone areas. Our study is demographic and socio-economic data.

Commercial activities in the growing WUI have increased in part by an expansion of residential development into the fire-prone areas. However, these communities often do not meet the same standards as the WUI areas that have been built. Thus, expanding WUI may affect the risk of residential loss dependent upon the nature of urbanization. We evaluate the impact of urbanization on fire risk in the WUI through time by using satellite data and remote sensing techniques to analyze changes in fire risk in the WUI through time by expanding into fire-prone areas. This research compares and expands previous

investigation by the principal investigators based on fire risk assessment using satellite imagery impacted wildland fire behavior and fire risk services including carbon sequestration and fire risk assessment at various spatial scales.

The study of residential fire losses is related to a myriad of complex and interacting factors, the influence of such factors varies by place. Population growth into fire-prone areas has resulted in greater exposure of residential development to wildland fire. Fire managers commonly employ multiple mitigation strategies to reduce the risk of fire loss in the WUI, one example is the practice of defensible space (initially surrounding a building to reduce structural ignition) via direct flame impingement or radiant heat transfer (California Public Safety 1996). To that end, the California Public Resources Code Section 4591 was updated in 2006 to require 30 ft of defensible space around buildings.

Given when defensible, defensible space may not prevent structural ignition from being reached, which is a more critical factor in residential losses than flame impingement or radiant heat (Gillis 2000). To mitigate potential structural losses, in 2009 California passed building codes for new construction to areas in which the state assumes the protective responsibility (California Public Resources Code 24, Part 2, Section 30). Under the new standards, all some portions of defensible space must be planted, including trees, shrubs, and other structures, decks, and others. While these standards will likely reduce fire loss in

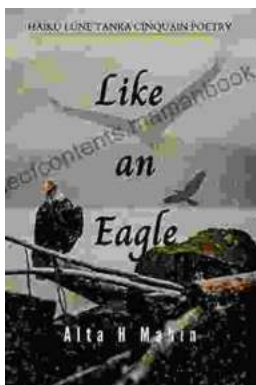

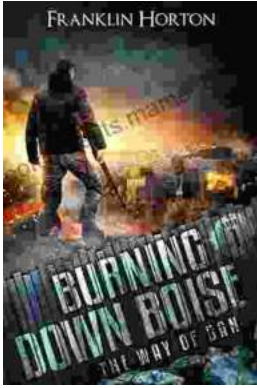
