What You'll Need

- Worsted weight yarn in two colors (one for the doll's skin and one for the doll's clothes)
- Size US 7 (4.5mm) knitting needles
- Yarn needle
- Stuffing
- Embroidery floss for the doll's facial features

Gauge

18 stitches and 24 rows = 4 inches in stockinette stitch

Pattern

Body

1. Cast on 36 stitches in the lighter color yarn.
2. Knit 12 rows.
3. Increase 6 stitches evenly across the row (42 stitches total).
4. Knit 12 rows.
5. Increase 6 stitches evenly across the row (48 stitches total).
6. Knit 12 rows.
7. Increase 6 stitches evenly across the row (54 stitches total).
8. Knit 12 rows.
9. Decrease 6 stitches evenly across the row (48 stitches total).
10. Knit 12 rows.
11. Decrease 6 stitches evenly across the row (42 stitches total).
12. Knit 12 rows.
13. Decrease 6 stitches evenly across the row (36 stitches total).
14. Bind off.

Head

1. Cast on 24 stitches in the lighter color yarn.

2. Knit 12 rows.
3. Decrease 6 stitches evenly across the row (18 stitches total).
4. Knit 6 rows.
5. Decrease 6 stitches evenly across the row (12 stitches total).
6. Bind off.

Arms (make 2)

1. Cast on 12 stitches in the lighter color yarn.
2. Knit 12 rows.
3. Increase 2 stitches evenly across the row (14 stitches total).
4. Knit 12 rows.
5. Bind off.

Legs (make 2)

1. Cast on 12 stitches in the lighter color yarn.
2. Knit 12 rows.
3. Increase 2 stitches evenly across the row (14 stitches total).
4. Knit 12 rows.
5. Increase 2 stitches evenly across the row (16 stitches total).
6. Knit 12 rows.
7. Bind off.

Hair

1. Cut a piece of yarn about 12 inches long.
2. Fold the yarn in half and tie a knot at the top.
3. Thread the yarn through a yarn needle.
4. Insert the yarn needle into the top of the doll's head and pull the yarn through.
5. Tie the yarn in a knot at the back of the doll's head.
6. Repeat steps 3-5 until the doll's head is covered in hair.

Facial Features

1. Use embroidery floss to stitch on the doll's eyes, nose, and mouth.
2. To stitch the eyes, make two small black dots.
3. To stitch the nose, make a small pink triangle.
4. To stitch the mouth, make a small red line.

Assembly

1. Sew the head to the body.
2. Sew the arms to the body.
3. Sew the legs to the body.
4. Stuff the doll with stuffing.

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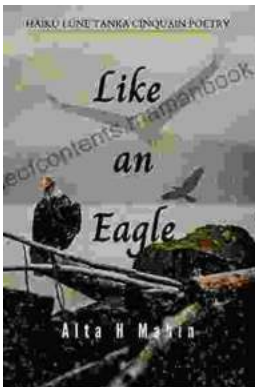
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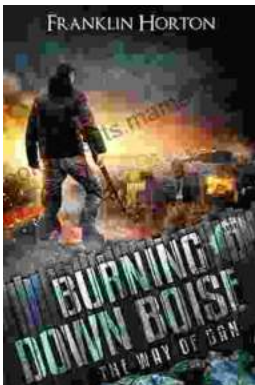
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
