Knit the front and back pieces separately, decreasing 1 stitch at the beginning and end of every other row until you have 15 stitches remaining on each piece. Join the pieces and

continue knitting in the round until the body measures 5 inches from the cast-on edge.

Head

Using cream yarn, cast on 40 stitches and knit in the round for 2 inches. Decrease 1 stitch at the beginning and end of every other row until you have 10 stitches remaining. Stuff the head with polyester fiberfill and close the opening with a tapestry needle.

Ears

Using cream yarn, cast on 12 stitches and knit in the round for 2 inches. Decrease 1 stitch at the beginning and end of every other row until you have 4 stitches remaining. Bind off and shape the ears by sewing the edges together.

Legs

Using brown yarn, cast on 15 stitches and knit in the round for 3 inches. Decrease 1 stitch at the beginning and end of every other row until you have 5 stitches remaining. Bind off and shape the legs by sewing the edges together.

Tail

Using black yarn, cast on 8 stitches and knit in the round for 1 inch. Bind off and shape the tail by sewing the edges together.

Assembly

Attach the head, ears, legs, and tail to the body using a tapestry needle. Embroider the eyes and nose with black yarn and create a mouth with a few stitches of black yarn.

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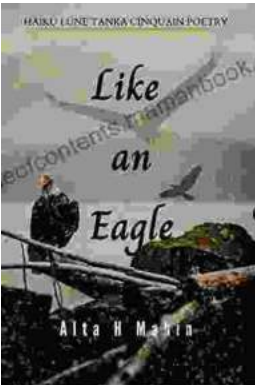
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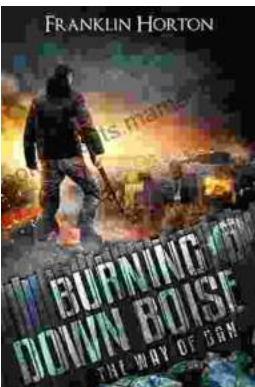


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
