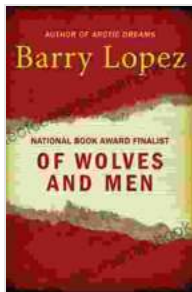


Of Wolves and Men: A Novel of Wolves and Wilderness

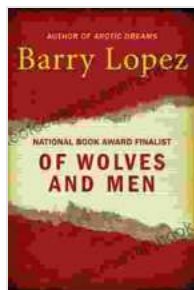

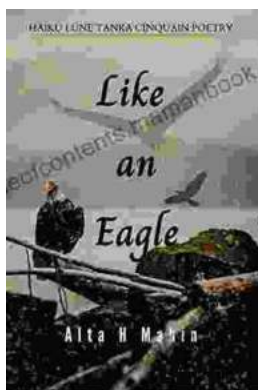

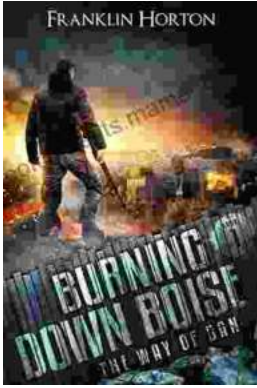
