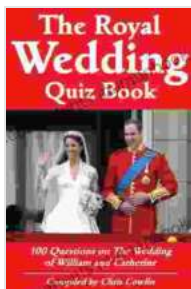

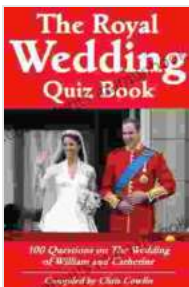
Answers

5. The tiara worn by the Duchess of Cambridge on her wedding day is the Cartier Halo Tiara.
6. The most expensive royal wedding in history was the wedding of Prince Charles and Lady Diana Spencer in 1981, which cost an estimated \$48 million.

7. The royal tradition where the groom gives the bride a gold ring with a Welsh knot is called the "Welsh Love Spoon" tradition.
8. The first royal bride to have a non-traditional wedding dress was Princess Anne, who married Captain Mark Phillips in 1973. She wore a white dress with a high neckline and long sleeves.
9. The royal wedding tradition where the bride throws her bouquet over her shoulder is called the "bouquet toss." The tradition is said to date back to the Middle Ages, when it was believed that the woman who caught the bouquet would be the next to marry.
10. The first royal wedding to be live-streamed on the internet was the wedding of Prince William and Catherine Middleton in 2011.
